

Future of Chemistry Scholarship Program for Hispanic Students

Overview

Scholarship Mission

CLARO's goal is to help Hispanic students planning to pursue studies in STEM. In an effort to increase diversity in these fields—including more specifically the representation of Hispanic or Latinx individuals in STEM and STEM-related fields, CLARO hopes to help students meet the financial challenges associated with college.

In 2022, we are funded to award 5 qualified students **\$5,000** each.



Criteria

In order to be considered for the ¡CLARO! Future of Chemistry Scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Applicants must be of Hispanic or Latinx ethnicity and completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted as a full-time student at a college or university for the upcoming academic semester. If scholarship money is awarded, this is the only program that will receive the funds on behalf of the applicant.
- Applicants plan to pursue studies in a field associated with STEM. Students in pre-medical programs who intend to go to medical, nursing, physician assistant or similar schools are not eligible for this scholarship.
- Applicants must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States.
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by March 15, 2022.
